What's your choice for paper thickness?

120 gr./m2 *approx. 80 gr./m2 paper, though the seeds make it feel like 120 gr./m2.*

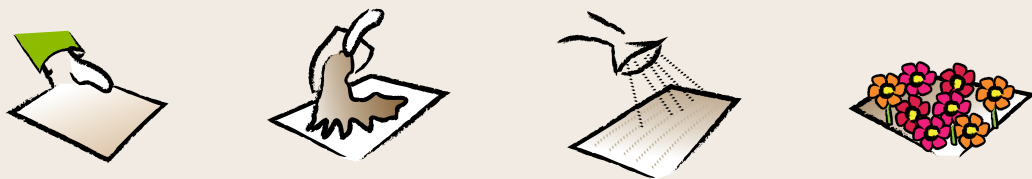
- ✓ Filled with European seeds
 - ✓ Production in EU
 - ✓ Available with various seeds
 - ✓ Quick germination because of the thin paper
 - ✓ Can be printed double-sided
 - ✓ Sturdy paper, which makes it suitable for various purposes
- ✗ Machine-produced

200 gr./m2 *handmade paper, so the amount of seeds and paper thickness could vary per sheet.*

- ✓ Thick and sturdy paper
 - ✓ Handcraft paper
 - ✓ Highly suitable for cards etc.
- ✗ Germination more difficult because of the thick paper
- ✗ Amount of seeds and paper thickness could vary per sheet
